The School Friend project is aimed at helping children and adolescents who are experiencing hardships adapt and learn how to interact with others.



We also encourage the children to find new hobbies and work to make sure they overcome any fears when it comes to communicating with other people.

Classes are led by volunteers, activists, students, university teachers, foundations and organizations.

To create additional opportunities for children and adolescents to successfully complete their school education

To help adolescents adapt to life in the real world and teach them social responsibility and commitment to the community



To make students take responsibility for helping to prevent deviant behavior and juvenile delinquency

Lectures and creative assignments to explore the nature, history and culture of Russia. Students will learn about the unique history of the regions, their attractiveness for tourists, the values of indigenous peoples and the development of the territories.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING BLOCK

Training and internships for professions in the service sector that do not require special qualifications

HOW TO GET ASSISTANCE?

- Wait for feedback from the supervisor and discuss the details
- Submit documents signed by the child's legal representative (confirmation of eligibility, consent to the processing of personal data, application for participation in the project)
- Receive confirmation and make a provisional class schedule

Ages: 10 to 18

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE?

- Children and adolescents living in orphanages, foster homes and crisis centres
- Children and adolescents from low-income families
- Orphans and children without parental care
- Children and adolescents with disabilities
- Children who are experiencing significant hardships
