

List of items prohibited from the Global Manufacturing and Industrialisation Summit 2019 (#GMIS2019) venue*

1. Explosives and related components, detonators, and items containing explosives.
2. Weapons of any kind, including firearms, pneumatic weapons, gas pistols, blades, projectiles, ammunition of any kind, weapon components, and riot control weapons and equipment.
3. Piercing or cutting objects, knives/blades, and any other objects that could be used as weapons.
4. Non-pyrotechnical devices and products (including self-made) which are used to disperse or spray various materials and substances (including pneumatic poppers) and other substances, products, or items (including self-made) capable of causing injury, combustion, or smoke.
5. Unmanned aerial vehicles of any maximum takeoff weight, and unmanned ground, water, or underwater vehicles.
6. Aerosols, compressed or liquefied gas.
Exceptions: pocket lighters, cosmetic products (eau de toilette, perfumes, etc.)
7. Flammable and pyrotechnical substances or products, including signal flares, hand flares, firecrackers, gas cylinders, and items/chemical materials which could be used to create pyrotechnical objects or smoke.
Exceptions: matches.
8. Highly flammable solids, liquids, or gases.
9. Oxidising agents and organic peroxides.
10. Toxic substances, radioactive materials, and corrosive substances.
11. Poisonous, noxious, and strong-smelling substances.
12. Narcotic, psychotropic, and toxic substances and their precursors, including in the form of medicines, as well as medical syringes and needles for injections.
Exceptions: injectable drugs, medical syringes, and needles, if medical documents are presented showing that they are essential.
13. Any granular substances, regardless of quantity.
Exceptions: permitted medicines in powdered form.
14. Liquids in containers larger than 500 ml.
15. Alcoholic beverages.
16. Any means of disguise/camouflage, or items hindering personal identification.
17. Body protection: bullet-proof vests, corsets (except where required for medical reasons).

* Excluding items used to support the running of #GMIS2019.

18. Any animals.
Exceptions: guide dogs with a passport and completed veterinary document.
19. Glass and metal containers, bottles, and jars.
Exceptions: transparent plastic food containers of up to 1.5 litres in volume.
20. Bulky items with a combined length, width, and height exceeding 150 cm.
21. Flags and banners larger than 2 m x 1.5 m in size.
Exceptions: flags up to 2 m x 1.5 m in size, if made exclusively from non flammable materials.
22. Flagpoles for flags or posters of any kind.
Exceptions: flexible plastic or double flagpoles (up to 1 m in length).
23. Materials of an extremist, offensive, or discriminatory character that incorporate Nazi paraphernalia or symbols, or paraphernalia or symbols of any other extremist organizations, or intended to in any way discriminate against a country, an individual or a group of individuals on the grounds of race; skin colour; ethnic, national or social origin and status; birthplace; financial or any other status; sex; disability; language; religion; political or any other opinions, including but not limited to banners, flags, symbols, paraphernalia, leaflets, and clothing.
24. Advertising materials of any kind, and any printed materials with religious, political, or offensive content or content that poses a threat to public order and/or decency (including banners, placards, posters, signs, and equivalent items).
Exceptions: religious books for personal use.
25. Any other hazardous substances and objects, as well as items prohibited from distribution within the Russian Federation.
26. Professional photography and video recording equipment.

Additional restrictions may apply during special events.
