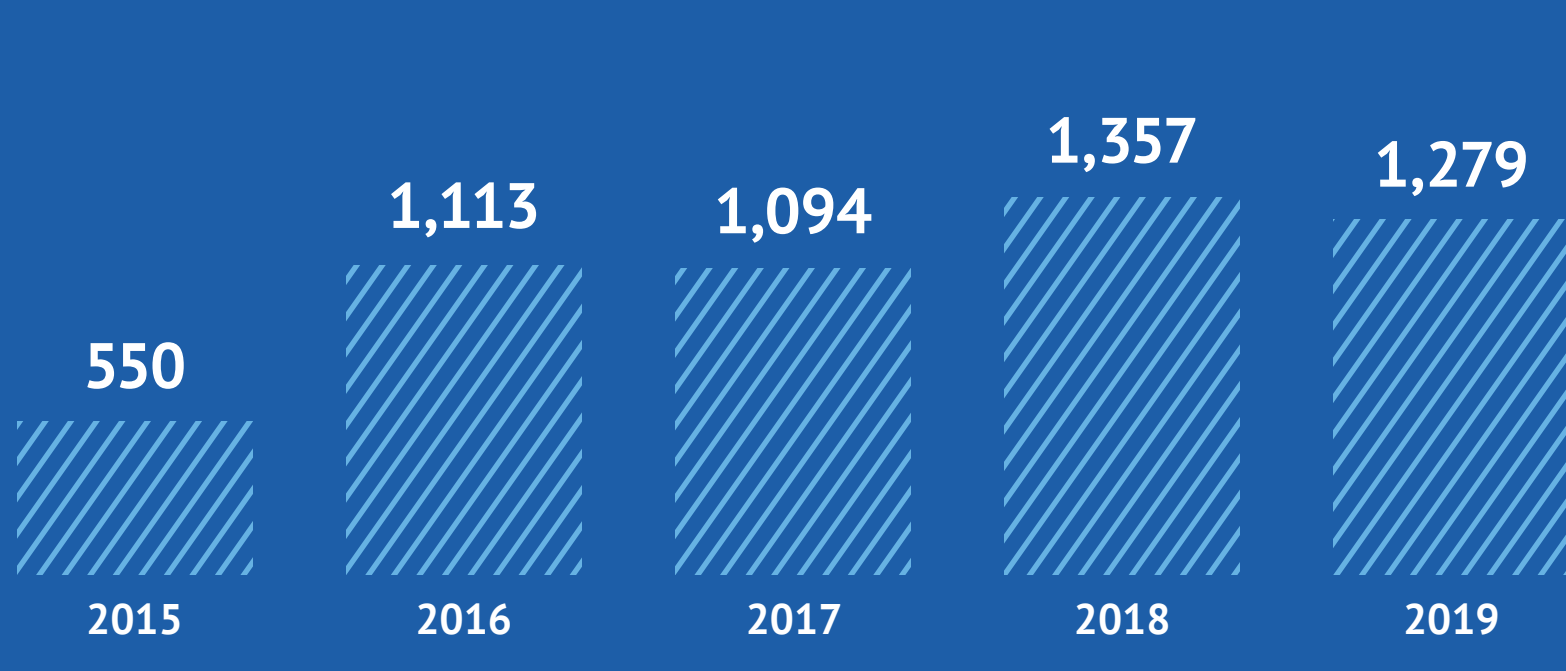

## INTERESTING FACTS

- 1 The Russian government officials present at the Forum included 21 heads of federal constituent entities of the Russian Federation, 14 Ministers of the Russian Federation, and 15 heads of federal services and agencies
- 2 At EEF 2019, India had its own pavilion called India Lounge which demonstrated the strengths of bilateral collaboration through major economic and strategic initiatives
- 3 The Forum brought together representatives of the International Olympic Committee and heads of National Olympic Committees of the Republic of Korea, Russia, and Japan
- 4 The programme of the Forum included over 100 events which were focused on the most pressing issues of the international and regional agenda
- 5 Around 600 volunteers from Vladivostok, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Arkhangelsk and Chelyabinsk participated in the Forum
- 6 According to preliminary estimates, 48 thousand guests visited the 'Far East Street' 2019 Exhibition, of which 40 thousand came in the last two days
